The Training

The beauty of our course is that training is provided on a one-to-one basis in the privacy of your own home by your own highly skilled Criminal Records Bureau vetted tutor.

Each session lasts between 1½ - 2 hours, given at a time that fits in with your personal commitments. Ideally there will be at least one lesson per week.

The range of topics covered is geared to your needs and includes social networking, emailing family and friends, online shopping, online banking and accessing services.

The Cost

The course is free to those on a weekly disposable income of less than £100. Above that course costs start at only £12.

What we do

We are a charity providing tuition to people with sensory, physical and age related disabilities, who want to learn how to use a computer and the Internet in their own home.

Our objective is for every person with a disability, who needs to have access to a computer at home, should get the training they need.

Who can apply

We welcome applications from any person with a sensory or physical disability living in London, various locations in Scotland, Merseyside, Manchester, South Wales, East Sussex, Kent, Essex and West Midlands.

Not in your area yet? Don't worry if your location is not listed above, we are recruiting new tutors, in new areas, all the time.

Equipment needed

To take our course you need access at home to a reasonably up-to-date computer with the means to connect to the Internet. We will carry out a preliminary assessment of your needs so you can get the most benefit from the course.

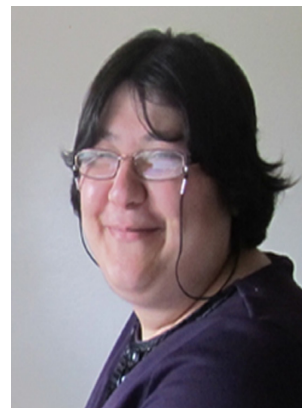
Sometimes we can provide free refurbished computers and adaptive software.
